- Leads the NCAA in tackles for loss (15, 2.14/gm) and forced fumbles (5, .71/gm).
- Leads the team with 8.5 sacks and ranks fifth nationally with 1.21 sacks per game.
- In SEC games, ranks first in the league in sacks and tackles for loss.
- Led the team with a career-high 13 tackles, 12 of which were solo vs. No. 3 Florida, and also recorded a team-leading three sacks, 4.5 tackles for loss in route to forcing and recovering two fumbles. Was named Walter Camp National Player of the Week, Nagurski National Defensive Player of the Week, College Football Performance Linebacker of the Week and SEC Defensive Player of the Week for second time of the season.

- Named the Walter Camp National Player of the Week, Nagurski National Defensive Player of the Week, SEC Defensive Player of the Week, College Football Performance Linebacker of the Week and the Lott IMPACT Player of the Week after win at Missouri.
- Named a quarterfinalist for the 2012 Lott IMPACT Trophy.
- Named one of 16 semifinalists for both the Maxwell Award and the Chuck Bednarik Award and also named to Phil Steele's 2012 Midseason All-American First-Team and Sports Illustrated's Midseason All-American list.
