Only the third time in 19 years UGA has opened the season on the road (L to Okl St in '09 & W vs Clemson in '03). Bulldogs had won 12 straight season openers through '08 but split the L/4.

LY was the first time both were ranked in the Top 10 (#5 & #6). It was over early as SC led 21-0 in the first 10 min. UGA scored with 1:55 to avoid getting shutout for the first time since '95.

First meeting. Last year they both played Florida Atlantic and while NT won 20-14 with a 6 yd edge the Bulldogs showed no mercy running up a school record 713 yds.

Georgia has dropped the L/2 falling 20-13 in '09 and 42-10 in the SEC Champ in '11. UGA dominated the title game early holding LSU to seven 3&outs but a LSU PR td turned the tide.

The Bulldogs have taken 3 straight while the home team in 5-1. LTH the Georgia D held Tennessee to 269 yards with 76 yds coming on their only td drive with under 3 mins left.

LY this was Missouri's first ever SEC game. It was scoreless after 1Q and 3-3 with under 2:00 left in the 2Q. Each scored a td before HT and MU took a 17-9 3Q lead before UGA outscored them 32-3.

The Bulldogs have won 10 straight in Nashville. LTH Georgia led wire-to-wire with 16 pts being their largest margin. UGA was +3 in TO's but settled for 6 fg att's missing 2.

Florida: LY both tm's came in ranked for the 2nd time in 5Y. The combined totals were 29 FD's. 539 yds, 5 sks and 9 TO's. The difference is Georgia had all 5 of the sks and were +3 in TO's.

First meeting. Georgia has played an FCS team each of the L6Y (6-0) winning by 38 ppg.

Georgia has won 6 of 7. The shutout LY was the first in the series since '76 (UGA 28-0).

UGA has won 16 of 17 at home with the loss coming in '09. LTH UGA had 4 fg's and a 10/3pl td drive.

UGA's taken 4 str, 6 in a row in Atlanta & 10 of 11 LY Bulldogs were outnaged by 47 yds but had a 5 SOD.
