49ERS DRAFT PARTY

The 49ers will hold their Annual Draft Party on Thursday, April 22 at the Santa Clara Convention Center. The sold out event will start at 3:45 p.m. PST.

- 49ers Head Coach Mike Singletary will address fans in attendance following the 49ers final first-round selection.
- Live NFL Network HD coverage of the first day of the draft on two giant video screens.
- Autograph sessions with current players, alumni, Gold Rush Cheerleaders and Sourdough Sam.
- A question-and-answer session on stage with the event MCs, former 49ers linebacker Gary Plummer and 49ers play-by-play voice Ted Robinson.
- 49ers inflatable games, sponsor booths, prize giveaways and concessions.
- Raffle tickets will be sold by 49ers Gold Rush Cheerleaders and fans will have the opportunity to win prizes including 49ers merchandise. All proceeds benefit the 49ers Foundation, which supports development programs for underserved youth to keep them safe, on track and in school.

49ERS IN THE FIRST ROUND

Since 1967, San Francisco has selected 47 first-round picks. Of those selections, 25 have been defensive players, while 22 have been offensive players.

The breakdown is as follows: defensive line (11), defensive back (8), wide receiver (6), linebacker (6), running back (5), offensive line (4), tight end (4) and quarterback (3).
