New Jersey Devils: Media Notes

Sat., Oct. 1; Philadelphia 1 at New Jersey 2

The Devils faced the Flyers for the second time in three days (Sept. 29 at Phi.), while closing out their pre-season schedule 3-3-0. Trailing 1-0 after the first period, **Petr Sykora** tied the game early in the second. Later that period, **David Clarkson's** second goal in as many nights proved to be the game-winning score. Sykora and Clarkson completed the pre-season schedule as the team's leading scorers with 2g-1a-3pts each. **Martin Brodeur** (24 saves) picked up the win in goal for New Jersey.

Training camp

Devils' training camp got underway at Prudential Center with rookies reporting on Thursday, September 15, and veterans reporting Friday, September 16. Overall, 59 players were in New Jersey's camp, including six goaltenders, 19 defensemen and 34 forwards.

New faces

Among the new faces in Devils' training camp were: goaltender **Keith Kinkaid** (f.a., 4/18); defensemen **Brandon Burlon** (2nd rd./2008), **Peter Harrold** (f.a., 8/12), **Adam Larsson** (1st rd./2011), **Reece Scarlett** (6th rd./2011), **Joe Sova** (f.a., 3/19) and **Anton Stralman** (tryout); and forwards **J.T. Barnett** (tryout), **Steve Bernier** (tryout), **Reid Boucher** (4th rd./2011), **Eric Boulton** (f.a., 7/15), **Mike Hoeffel** (2nd rd./2007), **Mike Sislo** (f.a., 4/6), **Stephane Veilleux** (f.a., 7/28), and **Joe Whitney** (f.a., AHL) Forward **Cam Janssen** (f.a., 7/14) was re-acquired, while forward **Petr Sykora** is attending training camp on a tryout basis.

Injuries

Center **Travis Zajac** (left Achilles tendon injury, suffered Aug. 17, 6 pre-season gms missed) is listed as injured, non-roster player.

Player moves

On Wednesday, the Devils signed right wing **Petr Sykora**. Also Wednesday, the club set its roster without signing defenseman **Anton Stralman**. On Tuesday, the team acquired a fourth-round pick in the 2012 NHL Entry Draft in exchange for center **David Steckel**. Also Tuesday, New Jersey assigned defenseman **Matthew Corrente**, **Peter Harrold** and **Jay Leach**; and forwards **Tim Sestito**, **Stephane Veilleux** and **Vladimir Zharkov** to Albany (AHL).

On Monday, the Devils assigned goaltender **Keith Kinkaid**; and defensemen **Matt Taormina** and **Alexander Urbom** to Albany. Also Monday, the club announced that free agent right wing **Steve Bernier** would not be signed. On Oct. 1, New Jersey assigned goaltender **Jeff Frazee**; and forwards **Matt Anderson**, **Stephen Gionta**, **Chad Wiseman** and **Steve Zalewski** to Albany.

On Sept. 24, the Devils reduced their training camp roster to 41, by assigning 14 players to Albany: goaltender **Maxime Clermont**; defensemen **Brandon Burlon**, **Eric Gelin**, **Dan Kelly**, **Joe Sova**, and **Harry Young**; and forwards **J.S. Berube**, **Mike Hoeffel**, **Kory Nagy**, **Nathan Perkovich**, **Mike Sislo**, **Myles Stoesz**, **Joseph Whitney**, and **Darcy Zajac**.

On Sept. 23, New Jersey returned five players to their junior teams: goaltender **Scott Wedgewood** (Plymouth, OHL); defenseman **Reece Scarlett** (Swift Current, WHL); and forwards **J.T. Barnett** (Kamloops, WHL), **Reid Boucher** (Sarnia, OHL) and **Thomas Nesbitt** (Ottawa, OHL).

Coming into tonight

Tonight, the Devils open their 30th season in the Garden State with the first game of a three-game homestand. The club is 0-1-1 in its last two season-opening contests, and looking for its first win since 2008-09. In fact, New Jersey is opening a campaign with three straight home games for the first time ever.

The Devils completed the 2010-11 season with a 38-39-5=81pt mark, including 22-16-3=45pts on home ice and 16-23-2=34pts on the road. The club failed to qualify for the Stanley Cup Playoffs for the first time since 1995-96, snapping the longest stretch in the Eastern Conference and the second-longest streak in the league. On March 12, New Jersey established a modern-day NHL record by reaching the NHL-.500 mark after being 19 games below .500 two months earlier.

The Devils will continue their current homestand Monday afternoon vs. Carolina (1:00 PM, MSG, The Apple 970 AM).

Openers

The Devils enter tonight's game 17-6-5 in their previous 28 season-opening contests, looking for their first victory since 2008. The club is opening the season vs. the Flyers for the first time since 1989, and just the fourth overall. New Jersey has never previously opened a season vs. Philadelphia on home ice.

Milestones

Devils' right wing **David Clarkson** needs two appearances to reach the 300 games-played mark in his NHL career. Defenseman **Mark Fraser** needs six games for 100, while defenseman **Andy Greene** needs nine games for 300. Right wing **Cam Janssen** needs five games for 100 with New Jersey.

Tuesday, September 20 –Flyers 4, Toronto Maple Leafs 0 at Air Canada Centre: Four different players scored and **Sergei Bobrovsky** recorded a 27-save shutout as the Flyers beat Toronto in the preseason opener. **Zac Rinaldo**, **Wayne Simmonds** and **Mike Testwuide** all contributed to a three-goal second period, while **Sean Couturier** picked up the second goal of his camp after also scoring in the Sept. 15 Rookie Game scrimmage against Washington. The shutout was the first for the Flyers in 108 total games spanning the preseason, regular season and playoffs, going back to the 2010 Eastern Conference Finals vs. Montreal.

Wednesday, September 21 –Toronto Maple Leafs 4, Flyers 2 at Wells Fargo Center: Toronto returned serve from the night before with a 4-2 win in the home exhibition opener for the Flyers. The Leafs jumped out to a 2-0 lead on goals by Juraj Mikus and Matt Frattin before **Tomas Hyka** scored on a breakaway out of the penalty box to make it 2-1 at the end of the second period. Joe Colborne scored for the Leafs about five minutes into the third period to make it a 3-1 lead. The Flyers answered one of the goals with just over two minutes to play when Eric Gustafsson put a loose puck home to make it 3-2. But Frattin scored an empty netter to spell the end for the Flyers.

Thursday, September 22: Detroit Red Wings 4, Flyers 3 (SO) at John Labatt Centre, London, Ontario –Wayne Simmonds scored with 53 seconds left and the goaltender pulled to force overtime, but the Red Wings prevailed in an eight-round shootout. The Flyers were down 3-1 with 2:45 remaining when **James van Riemsdyk** scored his second goal of the game, this one on the power play, to make it 3-2. van Riemsdyk had previously scored in the second period. The shootout saw only one player per team score in the first seven rounds before Ian White beat **Michael Leighton** in round eight to end it. Leighton made 38 saves on 41 shots before stopping six of eight in the shootout.

Friday, September 23: Flyers 3, Detroit Red Wings 1 at Joe Louis Arena –Jaromir Jagr had a goal and an assist in his Flyers debut as the Flyers beat the Red Wings. **Matt Read** also posted a goal and assist for the Flyers, while **James van Riemsdyk** provided

the club's other goal. The Flyers were trailing 1-0 late in the first period when Jagr set up van Riemsdyk for one goal and then scored his own in a 52-second span. **Sergei Bobrovsky** stopped 22 of 23 shots to pick up his second win of the preseason.

Monday, September 26: Flyers 5, New York Rangers 3 at Wells Fargo Center –**Jaromir Jagr** scored twice and **Braydon Coburn** put home the game-winner in the third period as the Flyers topped the Rangers to close out the day that saw the 2012 Bridgestone NHL Winter Classic officially announced at Citizen's Bank Park. The teams combined for a total of five power play goals, as both of Jagr's came on the man-advantage. **Matt Read** had another multi-point game with a goal and an assist, while **Danny Briere** and **Claude Giroux** each had three assists.

Thursday, September 29: Flyers 2, New Jersey Devils 1 at Wells Fargo Center –**Jaromir Jagr** scored on the power play with 8:12 remaining in the third period to lift the Flyers over the Devils in the home preseason finale. Jagr's goal was his third PPG of the preseason and fourth overall, and came on the tap-in of a spectacular setup by **Claude Giroux**, who earned the game's first star for his efforts. **Wayne Simmonds** scored the other goal for the Flyers, while **Ilya Bryzgalov** and **Sergei Bobrovsky** split the game in half –Bryzgalov stopped 17 of 18 in the first 29:30, after which Bobrovsky stopped all 13 shots he faced.

Saturday, October 1: New Jersey Devils 2, Flyers 1 at Prudential Center –**David Clarkson** scored on the power play with 4:21 to play, snapping a 1-1 tie and lifting the Devils to the win in the preseason finale for both clubs. **Scott Hartnell** gave the Flyers a 1-0 lead with a power play goal at 16:29 of the first period, but **Petr Sykora** tied it 4:12 into the second period to set the stage for Clarkson's game-winner. **Ilya Bryzgalov** made 18 saves in the loss.

PRESEASON HIGHLIGHTS

The Flyers went 8-for-32 on the power play in the preseason (25 percent). **Jaromir Jagr** scored three power play goals, which tied for the league lead with two other players.

Sergei Bobrovsky appeared in three games, playing all of two games and half of a third for a total of 151 minutes. He was 3-0 with a 0.40 GAA and a .984 save percentage. As a team, the Flyers had a 1.98 GAA and a .925 save percentage in the preseason.

Matt Read and **Claude Giroux** tied for the team lead in scoring. Read posted two goals and five assists for seven points in six games, while Giroux posted seven assists in four games. **Jaromir Jagr** and **Wayne Simmonds** tied for the team lead in goals scored with four goals apiece, while Read and Couturier tied for the team lead in plus-minus with a plus-4

Philadelphia Flyers: Head Coach and Player Bios

Head Coach: Peter Laviolette

Peter Laviolette was named the 17th head coach in Flyers history on Dec. 4, 2009. Over the final 57 games of the 2009-10 season, Laviolette coached the Flyers to a 28-24-5 record. He then led the club on a remarkable playoff run, picking up series wins over New Jersey (4-1), Boston (4-3) and Montreal (4-1) on the way to the eighth Stanley Cup Final appearance in Flyers history.

Laviolette previously spent parts of five seasons as head coach of the Carolina Hurricanes (2003-04 to 2008-09), where he compiled a 167-122-34 record in 323 games. In 2005-06, Laviolette led Carolina to the only Stanley Cup championship in franchise history, which culminated with a 3-1 win over Edmonton in Game 7 of the Stanley Cup Final on June 19, 2006. The Hurricanes won the Southeast Division that year with a record of 52-22-8, and set franchise records for wins and points (112) in a single season. Laviolette was named a finalist for the Jack Adams Trophy as NHL Coach of the Year that season.
