HOME OPENERS

This is the 44th home opener in Flyers history; they are 25-12-6 in their history on opening night. This is the 15th home opener for the Flyers here at the Wells Fargo Center, where they have a record of 8-4-1-1 on opening night.

Flyers are 25-12-6 all time in home openers.

Seven home openers have gone to overtime. The Flyers have only won one home opener in OT, in 2009-10.

This is the third time the Flyers have opened their home schedule against Vancouver. They won 7-3 in 1972-73 and 6-3 in 2000-01.

Here are some highlights from past opening nights at the Spectrum and Wells Fargo Center.

October 19, 1967: Flyers play their first game ever at the Spectrum, defeating the Pittsburgh Penguins, 1-0, on a goal by Bill Sutherland. Goaltender Doug Favell recorded the shutout.

October 17, 1968 –Flyers shut out Pittsburgh on opening night for the second consecutive season, 3-0.

October 19, 1969: Flyers 1, Montreal 1. Bobby Clarke plays in his first game at the Spectrum.

October 11, 1973: Kate Smith appears live at the Spectrum for the first time to perform "God Bless America." Flyers win 1973-74 season opener, 2-0, over Doug Favell and the Toronto Maple Leafs.

October 10, 1974 –Flyers raise their first Stanley Cup banner prior to a 5-3 loss to Los Angeles.

October 9, 1975 –Flyers raise their second Stanley Cup banner prior to a 5-4 win over Washington.

Oct. 11, 1979 –Flyers beat the New York Islanders 5-2. They lose two nights later in Atlanta, and then don't lose again until January 7, 1980.

October 7, 1982 –Flyers 9, Quebec 5. Most goals scored in a home-opener.

October 9, 1986: Rookie goaltender Ron Hextall makes his NHL debut vs. the Edmonton Oilers, winning 2-1.

October 8, 1987: The Kate Smith statue is dedicated outside the Spectrum prior to the team's season opener, a 2-2 tie against Montreal.

October 7, 1990 –Flyers 7, Detroit 2. Most decisive home-opening win.

October 11, 1995 –The Flyers beat Washington 2-1 in their final home opener at the Spectrum.

October 5, 1996 –The Flyers played their first regular season game at the CoreStates Center. The Florida Panthers won the game, 3-1, but right wing Dainius Zubrus became the youngest player in Flyers history at 18 years, three months and 20 days old on opening night. Zubrus also recorded his first NHL goal in the game.

NOTES OF THE NIGHT

Ilya Bryzgalov made 20 saves last Saturday to give the Flyers their first regular season shutout since **Brian Boucher** blanked Toronto 2-0 on April 6, 2010.

Saturday's win in NJ marked three Flyers firsts –**Matt Read** posted his first NHL goal, **Wayne Simmonds** picked up his first Flyers goal and **Ilya Bryzgalov** pitched his first shutout as a Flyer.

Sean Couturier has played more than four minutes on the penalty kill in each of the first two games this season.

The Flyers blocked 17 shots on opening night to Boston's nine, with five of those 17 blocked by Chris Pronger. Pronger played a Flyers game-high 24:34.

Jakub Voracek recorded the GWG against Boston in his first game as a Flyer. It was his first goal since March 9, ending a 16-game goalless streak.

The Flyers' opening night roster included eight players who did not play for the Flyers at any point last season (Lilja, Couturier, Simmonds, Read, Talbot, Jagr, Voracek, Bryzgalov). A ninth, **Zac Rinaldo**, only played during the postseason.

Sean Couturier is the first 18-year-old to make the Flyers opening night roster since defenseman **Luca Sbisa** did so in 2008. He and **Matt Read** made their NHL debuts last Wednesday, while **Zac Rinaldo** played his first NHL regular season game.

Jaromir Jagr recorded his 1,600th career point last Wednesday on his first-period assist on Claude Giroux's goal.

Philadelphia Flyers: Head Coach and Player Bios

Head Coach: Peter Laviolette

Peter Laviolette was named the 17th head coach in Flyers history on Dec. 4, 2009. Over the final 57 games of the 2009-10 season, Laviolette coached the Flyers to a 28-24-5 record. He then led the club on a remarkable playoff run, picking up series wins over New Jersey (4-1), Boston (4-3) and Montreal (4-1) on the way to the eighth Stanley Cup Final appearance in Flyers history.

Laviolette previously spent parts of five seasons as head coach of the Carolina Hurricanes (2003-04 to 2008-09), where he compiled a 167-122-34 record in 323 games. In 2005-06, Laviolette led Carolina to the only Stanley Cup championship in franchise history, which culminated with a 3-1 win over Edmonton in Game 7 of the Stanley Cup Final on June 19, 2006. The Hurricanes won the Southeast Division that year with a record of 52-22-8, and set franchise records for wins and points (112) in a single season. Laviolette was named a finalist for the Jack Adams Trophy as NHL Coach of the Year that season.

HEART OF A CANUCK

The 'Heart of A Canuck' season long celebration began Oct. 6/11 when the Canucks hosted many of their local heroes who displayed courage and passion for our great city on the night of June 15th. Representatives of local law enforcement, firefighters, paramedics, first responders and citizens joined players on-ice to acknowledge the record-setting 2010.11 Canucks season along with the many individual and team awards won by the club and its players.

The Canucks also unveiled newly installed on-ice projectors that, when partnered with the 40-foot display scrimms, HD big screens and 360 degree LED display, will significantly enhance the dramatic story telling capabilities in-arena each game night.

FALL FRENZY

In the past five seasons, Henrik Sedin has averaged more than a point-per-game in matches played in October. He has recorded 63 points (12-51-63) in 61 games played. Daniel Sedin has the second most points in the past five seasons on the Canucks, averaging more than a point-per-game with 52 points (21-31-52) in 51 games played. During those five seasons, the Canucks have the best winning record when Alex Burrows records a point. Vancouver is 13-5-0 when Burrows registers at least a single point (through Oct. 11/11).

IRON MAN

Canucks captain Henrik Sedin played in his 500th consecutive game Oct. 6/11 vs PIT. Henrik started his consecutive games played streak Mar. 21/04 vs CBJ. Calgary defenceman Jay Bouwmeester is the only active NHL player to have played more consecutive games at 506 games through the 2010.11 season.

NET GAINS

With a shutout, Apr. 7/11 vs MIN, Roberto Luongo moved into 18th all-time and 2nd among active goaltenders in shutouts. He is four shutouts from passing Clint Benedict and John Roach (T-58) to move into 16th all-time. Luongo also is among League leaders all-time

in wins. He is currently 21st all-time and 3rd among active goaltenders in wins. He has accomplished the feats under pressure. Only 12 goaltenders (two active) have faced more shots than Luongo's 20,126.

BANNER YEAR

Vancouver enters the 2011.12 season as the reigning Northwest Division Champions and keepers of the Presidents' Trophy as the team to compile the most regular season points in the entire League last year. The Canucks set franchise bests in points (117), wins (54), road wins (27) and road points (58). Individually, members of the Canucks were awarded the Art Ross Trophy and Ted Lindsay Award (Daniel Sedin), Selke (Ryan Kesler), Jennings Trophy (Roberto Luongo and Cory Schneider) and the GM of the Year Award (Mike Gillis). Collectively, the Canucks led the League in power play percentage (24.3%), goals for (3.15) and goals against (2.20). Following up on a successful regular season, the Canucks became the Western Conference Champions, defeating the San Jose Sharks in five games and came within one win of earning the franchise's first Stanley Cup.

V FOR VICTORY

Alain Vigneault is currently 10 wins away from moving past former Canucks Head Coach Marc Crawford (246) on the all-time wins list. Since joining the Canucks, Vigneault has led Vancouver to a Presidents' Trophy, Northwest Division title four out of five seasons with the club and won the Jack Adams Award following his first season with the Canucks. Vigneault's combined regular season record (237-134-41) represents the most successful winning percentage (.625) by a Vancouver Head Coach.

ON THIS DAY

The Vancouver Canucks earned the franchise's first ever win in their second game, a 5-3 victory at home versus the Toronto Maple Leafs. Wayne Maki scored two goals in the game.

Vancouver Canucks: Head Coach and Player Bios

Head Coach: Alain Vigneault

Alain Vigneault, 50, is the 16th Head Coach in franchise history. After being named to the position on June 20, 2006, he has led the Canucks to a Northwest Division title and postseason berth four times in five seasons with the club and won the Jack Adams Award as NHL Coach of the Year in 2007. Vigneault's combined regular season record (236-133-41) represents the most successful winning percentage (0.626) by a Vancouver Head Coach, while his 236 career wins rank second all-time in franchise history.

In 2010-11, Vigneault guided the club to a franchise best 54-19-9 record.
